Hours of Operation

Caswell, Burnett "Blonde" Pharr, South Austin and Austin Tennis Centers are all open 7 days a week. Hours are posted at each facility. Please call the facilities for more information - as hours change based on time of year.

The Tennis Centers are operated by contracted Tennis Professionals. Each facility offers public play, lessons, leagues and tournaments. Tennis merchandise and racket stringing services are provided at each facility. Courts may be reserved by calling the tennis center 2 days in advance.

Starting 9/1/2014 the Austin High Tennis Center has been converted to a FREE play facility. The courts are shared with the Austin Independent School District and are open to the public when school is not in session. The Pro Shop is closed and no court reservations are necessary (Further information below).

Courts are available on a first come first serve bases (Please limit play to one (1) hour when others are waiting) No private or group tennis lessons are allowed at any time nor is skateboards, roller blades, bicycles, scooters and other similar items on tennis courts. The lights are available 5 pm – 10:00 pm daily and are controlled by timers located on courts. **Please Note** – For a fee, courts may be reserved for league and tournament play.
